

Lady Tigers Improve to 5-1

The Clarksville Lady Tigers improved their District 19-A record to 5-1 by rolling past the Maud Lady Cardinals 50-25 in action played on Friday night in the Clarence L. Nix Jr. Gymnasium in Clarksville.

The Lady Tigers used strong defensive pressure particularly in the first half to record an alarming number of turnovers that led to transition points.

Coach Darrell Mickens' defensive group held the Lady Cardinals to single digit scoring in all four quarters.

Led by five first quarter points from Tirionna Woodberry the Lady Tigers scored the first 13 points of the opening quarter before ending the frame leading 15-1. Woodberry scored a game high 14 points for Clarksville.

Maud made just three field goals during the entire first half as the Lady Tigers led 28-9 at the intermission.

Michelle Warnell opened scoring in the third for the Lady Tigers with a basket off the break which triggered an 8-0 run that lifted Clarksville to a 36-9 advantage with 5:50 left in the period. The Lady Tigers would eventually move to the final period in control 44-17.

Warnell contributed eight points for Clarksville while Syiesha Coleman and Alison Parrish canned six points each. Shontae'adrian Bills added five points.

The Lady Tigers will entertain the Detroit Lady Eagles on Tuesday night.
