

Lady Tigers Take Down Lady Eagles

The Clarksville Lady Tigers remained in the mix for the District 19-A championship as Darrell Mickens team defeated the Detroit Lady Eagles 58-36 in a crucial league ballgame played Tuesday nigh in the Clarence L. Nix Jr. Gym. With the win Clarksville now holds a 6-1 district record with three games remaining on the schedule. The Lady Tigers trail first place Avery by one game.

The first quarter was quite close as the teams were tied 4-4 when Courtney Griffin scored for Detroit with 3:45 left in the first, but neither team would score again until Michelle Warnell answered for Clarksville with 1:14 left in the first and Alison Parrish scored the final basket of the frame to give the Lady Tigers an 8-4 lead as the teams moved to the second quarter.

Clarksville would build a 25-14 half-time lead before the Lady Eagles sliced the advantage to 25-20 with 5:50 left in the third. The Lady Tigers would enter the final quarter leading 37-25.

Warnell scored 14 points to lead Clarksville while Tirionna Woodberry added 10 points. Alison Parrish joined Sherika Parrish in canning nine points each.

Detroit was led by Griffin who recorded a game high 19 points while Shelton Waggoner contributed eight points.

The Lady Tigers will meet Avery in road action on this Friday night.
