

Clarksville ISD Faculty Dress Code

The District's dress code for faculty is established to ensure professionalism in appearance, prevent disruption and minimize safety hazards.

The district prohibits any clothing that, in the principal's judgment, may reasonably be expected to cause disruption of or interference with normal school operations. The intent of the dress code is that no skin be exposed from the neck to the knee for both faculty and students.

Faculty shall conform to the following rules:

Shirts:

Acceptable shirts are:

- Collared shirts – ex. Polo, golf style, or dress shirt
- Button front shirt or blouse
- Turtleneck
- Any shirt of modest apparel
- Spirit shirts on Friday only
- Neck lines should be no lower than the width of ones hand closed with fingers touching when the thumb is placed at the top of the breast bone.

Unacceptable shirts are:

- T-shirts
- See-through blouses or shirts
- Spaghetti-strap top/dress
- Backless apparel
- Exposed midriff
- Low necklines

Pants/skirts/dresses/gauchos:

- All of the above must fall at the knee
- Cargo pants with drawstring pant legs are not allowed
- Denim/Jeans may be worn on Friday, \$2 Tuesdays, and special occasions as determined by administration.
- Clarksville ISD wind suits may be worn on Friday.

*****Formfitting clothing is considered unprofessional and shall not be worn.***

[If you elect to wear jeans on Friday, a spirit shirt must be worn. Otherwise professional attire is expected.]

Shoes:

Men:

- Dress shoes
- Loafer style shoes
- Boots
- Socks must be worn with all footwear
- Tennis shoes on Friday or \$2 Tuesday

Women:

- Dress shoes
- Loafer style shoes
- Boots
- Open toe style dress sandals
- Tennis shoes on Friday or \$2 Tuesday

Physical education staff members may choose to wear appropriate uniforms, approved by administration, during the physical education instructional period only.

Instructors in laboratory courses may wear aprons, smocks, or jeans during the instructional period only.

*****The campus principal or other district-level administrative personnel will make final decisions concerning staff dress.***
