Student Dress Code
2009-2010

The CISD dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, prevent disruption and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

Shirts

- Shirts will be one of the following:
 - Crew neck
 - Button up (no more than the top button unbuttoned)
 - Polo type (no more than the top button unbuttoned)
- Hoodies will not be allowed.
- Boys must tuck all shirts.
- Girls must tuck all shirts that fall below the wrist when the arms are placed at the side.
- Midriffs must be covered at all times.
- Neck lines should be no lower than the width of ones hand closed with fingers touching when the thumb is placed at the top of the breast bone.

Pants/Skirts/Shorts/Dresses

- Dresses, skirts and shorts must come to the knee.
- Students will wear a belt when their shirt is tucked.
- When wearing tights or leggings the top must come to the knees.
- No holes will be allowed in pants.

Shoes

- Students must wear shoes.
- Students can wear most types of shoes or boots.
- House shoes will not be allowed.

Other

- Not hats, caps, toboggans, scarves, etc. can be worn inside the building.
- Any type of clothing that would tend to cause a distraction will not be allowed. Examples could include clothing displaying alcohol, tobacco, drugs, racial slogans, gestures, wording in bad taste, sagging pants, visible undergarments, etc.
- All piercing will be limited to the ear.

The campus Principal/Assistant Principal will make final decisions concerning student dress. When a student is in violation of the student dress code, the school will provide appropriate clothing for that day. Students who continually violate the dress code policy will be disciplined according to the Student Code of Conduct.
